The National Diabetes Audit (NDA) team is keen to support mechanisms that improve the care for people with diabetes. Building upon the success of our previous collaboratives in foot care, pregnancy in diabetes, in-patient care and transitions (download the [report here](#)), we are now seeking to recruit Networks to join a collaborative to enhance the use of National Diabetes Audit data.

Would you like to join us?

We are inviting Networks who would like to participate in an exercise to describe and enhance their current use of National Diabetes Audit data. The collaborative is open to Diabetes Clinical Networks and other diabetes related networks e.g. Diabetes Footcare or Cardiovascular Networks. The information collated and the learning gathered will be used to inform other Networks and hence enhance the content and delivery of all the NDA workstreams.

The offer

We are looking for TWO Networks to go through a staged process to describe and enhance current use. It is anticipated that this will involve:

- Collating information on audit data and outputs and their current network-level use
- Identifying how audit data and outputs could be used to support improvement particularly in areas prioritised by transformation funding
- Testing new ways of using the audit data
- Disseminating learning to other Networks, NHS Digital and other national audits

This work will take place from February 2021 to May 2022. The first webinar will take place on 23rd February (2pm-4pm) on Zoom or Microsoft Teams.

How to apply?

There is no charge for this work, but we do require commitment to engage with the webinars and to develop, implement and evaluate changes.
